

A Simple Program to Restore Our Country

First: Non-intervention

Third: Stable Currency

Americans need the ability to control their own futures. This can not be done if the value of their savings is stolen by bad currency policies.

Interventionism, over regulation and intentional currency inflation all reduce the buying power of the dollar, and undermine our individual abilities to save.

All governments are funded by a combination of taxation, borrowing, and theft. Currency tied to gold and silver limit the government's ability to fund its actions to a level sustainable without damaging the economy. or stealing the savings of the people. In that stable environment saving makes real sense.

Fourth: Limited Government

Government should never undertake any function not specified in the constitution. When it does so the effects are bad for the economy and the people. There is no stability when the government exceeds the mandate of the constitution.
